Eligibility: Applicants will be assessed against the following Criteria

1. Considered to have the potential to be a participant in the Olympic/Paralympic Games or equivalent for learning disabilities, the National Team of their sport within the next 5 years by his/her sports body, coach, club or school.
2. Living in or representing a club within the borough of Ashford.
3. The financial support already available or potentially available from other sources
4. Achievements to date

Applications

An application form is attached. This should be completed and submitted to: **Simon Harris, Active Ashford Bursary, Ashford Borough Council, Cultural Services, Civic Centre, Tannery Lane, Ashford, Kent, TN23 1PL** together with a report from the applicant's coach, sports association or club. The Scheme will be open to receive applications during each calendar year until available Bursary funds have been fully allocated. Applicants judged by the panel to best fit the assessment criteria (see eligibility above), will be asked to meet with the representatives.

- (a) identify their sporting ambitions and why they think they are candidates for achieving a place in the National Team or region for their sport
- (b) state their own case as to why they would benefit from such additional support
- (c) provide additional information if requested

Awards

- * Bursaries may be awarded wholly or partially to one or more applicants depending upon how closely they match the criteria and what level of support is required.
- * The bursary will be made available for an agreed period from the date the award is made.
- * It will be paid against specific agreed receipted costs.
- * The panels judgment will be final.
- * Applicants are only able to submit one application per year.
- * The maximum amount allocated to an individual is £750.
